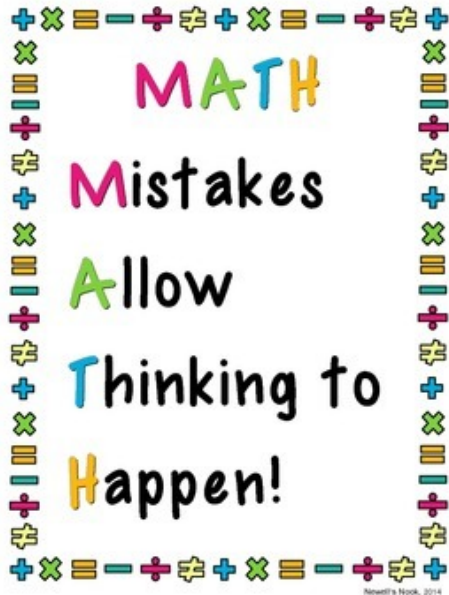

Course Objective:

In Grade 7, instructional time should focus on four critical areas: (1) developing understanding of and applying proportional relationships; (2) developing understanding of operations with rational numbers and working with expressions and linear equations; (3) solving problems involving scale drawings and informal geometric constructions, and working with two- and three-dimensional shapes to solve problems involving area, surface area, and volume; and (4) drawing inferences about populations based on samples.

Grading Scale:

Grades are based on the following scale:

90% – 100%: A

80% – 89% : B

65% – 79% : C

50% – 64% : D

0% – 49% : F

Late/Missing Work:

Missing Work will be documented with an "M" in the gradebook. An "M" will count as 0 points until turned in. Students will have access to missing assignments in class and online in TEAMS. Assignments must have **full name, class period, and date turned in**. Assignments will be turned in in baskets labeled with class period. It is the responsibility of the student to pick up missing assignments or print online and turn them in on a timely manner. Students will have until the end of the following Module to turn in missing work. Test Retakes will be allowed until the end of the Quarter. Check ATLAS for missing assignments.

Behavior Plan

Our class behavior plan will involve the following steps, order will vary according to each circumstance:

- 1) In class, behaviors will be addressed verbally and tracked by teacher.
- 2) If needed, students' seat will be moved.
- 3) Students unable to redirect themselves with 3 verbal warning will be asked to step outside of class to reflect.
- 4) If the behavior is continued, assigned lunch detention and Parents/Guardians will be contacted.
- 5) Students who skip lunch detention will be assigned after school detention with administration involvement.
- 6) Referrals and ATLAS will be used to document behaviors, detention assignments, and home contact.
- 7) Students who display continued disruptive behaviors will be temporarily assigned to the Reengagement Center to work on assignments independently.
- 8) Restorative Circles will be held as needed before being re-admitted to class.

Athletics/Extracurriculars

Students who miss class for Athletics or Extracurricular Activities are not excused from classwork done that day. Students will be expected to make up any work, if not turned in, the assignment will be documented with an "M" which is still considered a zero.

Technology

Cell phones and Earbuds are not allowed in class *unless teacher notifies students ahead of time*. Students will be given one verbal warning to put cells away, if taken out again, cell phone will be confiscated by teacher. First confiscation will end in phone being returned after class, second time, cell will be returned to student after school, and beyond this, phones will be taken to the office where a parent/guardian will be required to pick it up. Cell phones turned into the office **will not** be released to students. Earbuds are not to be worn in/on ears, even with music off. They must be hanging off shirt collar, or put completely away. Confiscation rules will follow those of Cell Phones.

Resources for Home

Online Math resources **MyHRW** and **Khan Academy** are accessible on most devices. Students can log on through their student portal (**ATLAS**). On MyHRW, classwork is found under the "**My Assignments**" tab. For online assignments to be graded, they **must be submitted**. Unsubmitted assignments are not logged/graded.
